

Economic Injury Disaster Loan Terms



What are the collateral requirements?

- Economic Injury Disaster Loans over \$25,000 require collateral
- SBA takes real estate as collateral when it is available.
- SBA will not decline a loan for lack of collateral, but requires borrowers to pledge what is available.

The maximum unsecured loan amount is \$25,000.

Applicants can have an existing SBA Disaster Loan and still qualify for an EIDL for this disaster, but the loans cannot be consolidated

Ineligible Entities

What are some of the businesses that are ineligible for an Economic Injury Disaster Loan?

- Agricultural Enterprises -If the primary activity of the business (including neither the business nor its affiliates are eligible for EIDL assistance its affiliates) is as defined in Section 18(b)(1) of the Small Business Act,
- Religious Organizations
- Charitable Organizations
- Gambling Concerns (Ex: Concerns that derive more that 1/3 of their annual gross revenue from legal gambling activities)
- Casinos & Racetracks (Ex: Businesses whose purpose for being is gambling (e.g., casinos, racetracks, poker parlors, etc.) are not eligible for EIDL assistance regardless of 1/3 criteria above

Coastal Barrier Resources Act (Public Law 97-348)

Applicants whose property has been determined by the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Flood Insurance Rate Naps (FIRM's), to be in a Coastal Barrier Resource Area (COBRA), are ineligible for SBA loan assistance due to Public Law.

making any loan for: The Coastal Barrier Resources Act (Public Law 97-348) prohibits Federal financial assistance to applicants located in the Coastal Barrier System.
Consequently, under the provisions of the law, for those applicants in the Coastal Barrier Resource Area, SBA Disaster Assistance is prevented from

- (1) replacement or repair of physical damages or,
 (2) funds for economic injury losses or,
 (3) funds for relocations out of the Coastal Barrier Resources Area.

If you are a vacationer, or transient staying in the area on vacation, you may have eligibility for your personal property losses. To establish this eligibility you will be asked to provide documentation of your presence in the area at the time of the disaster and to support that your stay was temporary in nature.

REAL ESTATE REPAIRS/TEXAS HOMESTEAD LAW

homestead law directly affects SBA, as well as other lenders, who provide funds for the repair or acquisition of homestead property. If you intend to apply for any SBA funds to repair your home or family business, please carefully read and comply with the following. Texas law provides extensive protection for "homestead" property. Homestead property includes your personal residence, and, in many cases, your family business. Texas

If you are waiting on SBA funds to begin your repairs, SBA will prepare and include all equired mechanic's lien documents with your closing papers, if and when your loan is approved.






